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Carnet de Passages - renewal or extension for New Zealand

If you want to stay longer in New Zealand and the validity of your Carnet is going to expire, you may apply for an extension. Customs authority of New Zealand must approve this extension. This decision depends mostly on the validity of your visa. Please apply for the extension on time so that no problems with the customs authority of New Zealand occur. If the extension is denied, you will have to export the vehicle before the expiry date.

Please first contact the automobile club in New Zealand (NZAA) approx. 6 weeks before your Carnet expires.

After receipt of money we will send the NZAA our approval.



If the application to extend the Carnet has been approved, you must pay an extension fee of 150 NZD to NZAA as well. The new expiry date will be filled in the Carnet. Therefore the Carnet has to be presented to the NZAA and customs authority of New Zealand so that the new expiry date will be noted by the customs authority. There are only a few exceptions when a Follow-up Carnet may be presented for an extension.

If a Follow-up Carnet is required, we need a new application form filled in and signed. The issuing fee and if necessary the dispatch fee have to be paid again. The already lodged deposit will be transferred. Please note that the vehicle value may not be reduced in the Follow-up Carnet!

As soon as you have received the Follow-up Carnet, please present both Carnets to the NZAA and the customs authority.

Afterwards please send the old Carnet along with a copy of the first page inside of the Followup Carnet back to our office in Munich. The copy must contain the entry stamp, vehicle data and the customs note.
