Carnet extension for the territory of Australia

If you stay longer in Australia and the validity of your Carnet is going to expire, you may apply for an extension. Australian customs authority have to approve this extension. This decision depends mostly on the validity of your visa. Please get in contact with the Australian customs authority on time so that no problems occur. If the extension is denied, you will have to export the vehicle before the expiry date. If you miss the date, you will have to pay the customs duties as well as a customs penalty of AU\$ 12,000!

Please first contact the automobile club in Australia approx. 6 weeks before your Carnet de Passages expires.

The Australian automobile club will inform ADAC about this extension and ask for our approval. If we have no objection against this extension, a fee will be charged and has to be paid to ADAC. The extension fee is based on the issuing fee and has to be paid proportional to the length of extension. After receipt of money we will give the Australian automobile club the approval.

The Carnet has to be presented to the Australian automobile club and Australian customs authority who will fill in the new expiry date in the Carnet. There are only a few exceptions when a Follow-up Carnet may be presented in order to receive the extension.
